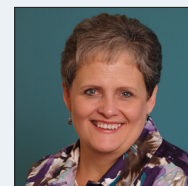

## Cognitive Coaching: Problem Solving (Level II)

**Target Audience:** All grade levels and subject areas

**Cognitive Coaching (Level II)** is a four-day experience during which participants will build their communication and problem-solving skills through the process of becoming intentional about how they mediate for someone else's effectiveness. The problem-solving conversation will be presented, and the planning and reflecting maps will be reviewed. Research, modeling and practice will support learning. Previous participation in Level I or in the full eight-day training is required. Cognitive Coaching is a process that supports individuals working together to improve their skills.
